AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE PRINTING AND DISTRIBUTION OF CERTAIN STATE DOCUMENTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 4 of chapter 5 as appearing in the 1990 Official Edition
2 of the General Laws, is hereby amended by striking out the first
3 paragraph and inserting the following new paragraph: —
4 The state secretary may also, at the close of each regular ses-
5 sion of the general court, provided in loose leaf form such number
6 of copies, not to exceed two thousand five hundred, as he may
7 determine, of the acts and resolves passed and of any proposed
8 amendments to the constitution passed during such session, and
9 shall at his discretion apportion said copies, accepting one thou-
10 sand which he may reserve in his office, for general distribution,
11 among the clerks of several towns, to be delivered by them to
12 such inhabitants thereof as applied therefor.
