RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY THE EXECUTIVE OFFICE OF ECONOMIC AFFAIRS RELATIVE TO THE UTILIZATION OF GEOGRAPHIC INFORMATION SYSTEMS (GIS) IN ITS OPERATIONS.

1 *Resolved*, That the executive office of economic affairs is hereby
2 authorized and directed to investigate and study the utilization
3 of geographic information systems (GIS) in its operations as
4 developed by the department of environmental affairs. Said office
5 shall analyze the many responsibilities and duties it has under law
6 and the feasibility of maximizing the utilization of the geographic
7 information systems in meeting its responsibilities to the business
8 community and the commonwealth.

9 Said executive office shall consult with and cooperate with the
10 executive office of environmental affairs and said executive office
11 of environmental affairs shall provide any and all informa-
12 tion, documents, papers, studies and reports at no charge to the
13 executive office of economic affairs in furthering its investigation
14 and study.

15 The executive office of economic affairs shall report to the gen-
16 eral court the results of its investigation and study, and its recom-
17 mendations, if any, together with drafts of legislation necessary to
18 carry such recommendations into effect, by filing the same with
19 the clerk of the house of representatives on or before the last
20 Wednesday in December, nineteen hundred and ninety-three.
