AN ACT ESTABLISHING A SECOND ASSISTANT REGISTER TO THE PLYMOUTH COUNTY REGISTER OF DEEDS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 36 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting
2 after 6 the following section: —

3 Section 6A. The register of deeds for the County of Plymouth
4 may, by writing recorded in his registry, designate one of the per-
5 sons employed therein as second assistant register who shall serve
6 at the pleasure of such register and who, at the election of such
7 register, may at any time be returned to their former position, also
8 by a writing recorded in his registry. Such person shall have all
9 the powers and authority vested in an assistant register.
