## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ninety-Five.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE BONDING OF CONSTABLES USING 4C MOTION FOR THE SERVICES OF PROCESS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 When the court allows a 4C motion allowing Constables to
- 2 serve process beyond the allowed ad damnum, a bond two times
- 3 the damage amount should be secured.
- 4 Presently a Constable must provide \$5,000 bond for process up
- 5 to the amount of \$2,500.00.
- 6 This bond would assure the plaintiff is protected for any errors
- 7 or omissions.
