In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ninety-Five.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE APPOINTMENT OF CONSTABLES IN CITY/TOWNS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 It should be provided that one Constable should be appointed or
- 2 elected for every 10,000 population.
- 3 This act would insure that there would not be an overabundance
- 4 of Constables that will become servile to those they serve process
- 5 for.
