AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE FEDERAL PROTECTION SERVICE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 10 of chapter 147 of the General Laws, as appearing in
2 the 1988 Official Edition, is further amended by the insertion after
3 Section 10M the following section: —

4 Section 10N. The commissioner may at the request of the
5 Federal Protective Service appoint as a special police officer
6 employees of said agency. Such special police officer shall serve
7 for one year, subject to removal by the Commissioner and shall
8 have the same powers to make arrests as regular police officers
9 for any criminal offense committed in or upon the property, lands,
10 buildings or structures owned, used, leased or under the authority
11 of the General Services Administration.
