

ACTS, 1984. - Chaps. 18, 19.

SECTION 3. There is hereby established in said town a park commission whose members shall be the members of the board of selectmen. Said park commission shall have all the powers and duties granted by the various provisions of the General Laws and such additional powers and duties as are established by town by-law not inconsistent with the General Laws.

SECTION 4. Chapter seven of the acts of nineteen hundred and thirty-nine is hereby repealed.

SECTION 5. If a majority of the votes cast on April fourteenth, nineteen hundred and eighty-four on the ballot question: "Shall the town vote to have its selectmen act as park commissioners?" is in the affirmative, then section three shall take effect and section two shall be inoperative. If the number of votes cast, on April fourteenth, nineteen hundred and eighty-four, in favor of said ballot question is less than a majority, then section two of this act shall become effective and section three shall be inoperative.

SECTION 6. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

Chap. 18. AN ACT DESIGNATING SECTIONS OF STATE HIGHWAY ROUTE 122 AS THE "BLACKSTONE CANAL HERITAGE HIGHWAY".

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

The section of state highway route 122 from the Worcester-Millbury town line to Central street in the town of Millville, and the section of state highway route 122 from the Blackstone-Millville town line to the Rhode Island - Massachusetts state border; shall be designated and known as the "Blackstone Canal Heritage highway". Suitable markers bearing said designation shall be erected thereon by the department of public works.

Chap. 19. AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE CONDUCT OF CERTAIN GAMES CONDUCTED AT ELDERLY HOUSING PROJECTS.
