**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ninety-Five.

AN ACT PROVIDING THAT THE STATE EMPLOYEE MEMBERS OF THE GROUP INSURANCE COMMISSION SHALL BE NOMINEES OF THE RESPECTIVE STATE EMPLOYEE ORGANIZATIONS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 3 of Chapter 32A of the General laws, as appearing in  
2 the 1992 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out the  
3 first sentence and inserting in place thereof the following: —  
4 There shall be established within the executive office of adminis-  
5 tration and finance, but not under its jurisdiction, a special unpaid  
6 commission, to be known as the group insurance commission,  
7 consisting of the commissioner of administration and finance, the  
8 commissioner of insurance, and nine members to be appointed by  
9 the governor, one of whom shall be a retired state employee, one  
10 of whom shall be a health economist, and at least three of whom  
11 shall be full-time state employees, of whom one shall be a mem-  
12 ber and nominee of the Massachusetts Public Employees Council,  
13 #93, AFSCME, one of whom shall be a member and nominee of  
14 the National Association of Government Employees, NAGE, and  
15 one of whom shall be a member and nominee of Local 254,  
16 S.E.I.U.
