AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE STATUS OF CERTAIN TEMPORARY EMPLOYEES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 116 of Chapter 164 of the Acts of 1988 is
2 hereby amended by striking out the words "the department of cor-
3 rections filled by correction officers" appearing in the first sen-
4 tence thereof and by inserting in place thereof the following
5 words:— all departments of the Commonwealth filled by tempo-
6 rary employees who are.

1 SECTION 2. The provisions of this act shall become effective
2 on July first, nineteen hundred and ninety-five.
