AN ACT PROVIDING FOR BINDING INITIATIVES IN TOWNS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Chapter 53 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting
- 2 after section 18A the following section:—
- 3 Section 18B. Any town may provide by by-law that ten percent
- 4 of the registered voters or two hundred such voters whichever is
- 5 less may place a binding initiative on the ballot at any regular
- 6 town elections.
