## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ninety-Five.

### AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE APPEAL OF CERTAIN CASES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 231 of the General Laws is hereby  
2 amended by striking out section 97 and inserting in place thereof  
3 the following section: —

4 Section 97. A party aggrieved by the judgment of the district  
5 court in a civil action may appeal said judgment to the appeals  
6 court consistent with the provisions of section one hundred nine  
7 and rules of appellate procedure.

1 SECTION 2. Section 102C of said chapter 231 as appearing in  
2 the 1992 Official Edition is hereby amended by striking out the  
3 fifth paragraph.

1 SECTION 3. The second paragraph of section 104 of said  
2 chapter 231 as so appearing is hereby amended by striking out the  
3 third and fourth sentences.

1 SECTION 4. Sections ninety-eight, ninety-one, one hundred  
2 one, one hundred three, one hundred four A, one hundred six and  
3 one hundred seven are hereby repealed.
