AN ACT FURTHER PROTECTING THE WATER RESOURCES OF THE COMMONWEALTH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section two B of chapter one hundred and sixty-five of the
2 General Laws, as most recently amended by section one hundred
3 and ninety-five of chapter one hundred and ten of the Acts of 1993,
4 is hereby amended by inserting at the end thereof the following new
5 language:— Provided however, that all residential buildings of more
6 than one unit, serviced by a single meter, shall be billed at rates that
7 reflect the usage per unit. All municipalities or water districts shall
8 divide the metered water usage by the number of units served by that
meter to determine the correct billing block.
