AN ACT INCREASING THE FINES FOR FAILING TO STOP FOR A SCHOOL BUS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 14 of Chapter 90 of the Massachusetts General Laws,
2 as appearing in the 1990 Official Edition, is hereby amended by
3 striking out the word "one" in line thirty and inserting thereof the
4 word "two"; striking out the word "two" in line thirty-one and
5 inserting thereof the word "three"; striking out the word "three" in
6 line thirty-three and inserting thereof the word "four"; striking out
7 the word "four" in line thirty-three and inserting thereof the word
8 "five"; by striking out the word "five" in line thirty-six and
9 inserting thereof the word "six"; and by inserting the words "one
10 hundred" after the word "thousand" in line thirty-six.
