AN ACT RELATIVE TO CORRESPONDENCE OF INMATES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 87 of Chapter 127 of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended in the first sentence by striking the words "and deposit
3 them, sealed, in locked letter boxes" and inserting the words "for
4 delivery by federal postal authorities" and in the second sentence
5 by striking the words "letters so deposited" and inserting the
6 words "such letters".
