AN ACT ESTABLISHING A MASSACHUSETTS HALL OF FAME FOR METROPOLITAN OPERA ARTISTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 6 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 1992 Official
2 Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after section 20 the
3 following section:—

4 Section 20a. The commission shall establish and administer a
5 Hall of Fame for Metropolitan Opera artists who have attained a
6 tenure of at least thirty years since the establishment by President
7 John F. Kennedy of the National Endowment of the Arts. Said
8 Hall of Fame shall be named the Massachusetts Hall of Fame for
9 Metropolitan Opera Artists.
