AN ACT RELATIVE TO MEDICAL MALPRACTICE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 5A of Chapter 112 of the General Laws, as appearing in
2 the 1992 Official Edition, is hereby amended at the end by insert-
3 ing the following:— The board of registration in medicine is
4 directed to establish regulations to restrict or revoke a physician's
5 license when, after a hearing, the physician is found to have a sig-
6 nificant record of malpractice complaints, charges, or disciplinary
7 actions.
