AN ACT DIRECTING THE RE-ENLISTMENT AND REINSTATEMENT OF ROLAND J. MARTINEAU AS A SERGEANT FIRST CLASS (E-7) IN THE MASSACHUSETTS NATIONAL GUARD.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of any general
2 law or special law to the contrary, the Adjutant General of the
3 Massachusetts National Guard is hereby authorized and directed
4 to re-enlist and re-instate Roland J. Martineau of Swansea,
5 Massachusetts into the Massachusetts National Guard as a
6 Sergeant First Class/E-7 with an effective date of enlistment of
7 November 1, 1989.

1 SECTION 2. The adjutant General is further authorized and
2 directed to credit Roland J. Martineau with all pay, allowances,
3 and benefits, at the active duty rate of a soldier with the pay grade
4 and length of service reflected in Roland J. Martineau's NGB
5 Form 22, from November 1, 1989 to the date of this Act's accep-
6 tance. The monies to fund this act shall be taken from the National
7 Guard's incidental and contingency budget and if this budget shall
8 prove inadequate then from the General Treasury of the
9 Commonwealth.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
