AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING CLAIMS AGAINST THE COMMONWEALTH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 4 of chapter 258 of the General Laws, as appearing in
2 the 1990 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the
3 word "section" in line 7 the following:— , provided, however, if
4 the court finds that through no fault of the claimant and with no
5 prejudice to the commonwealth or any of its agencies or depart-
6 ments, it was impossible to know the defendant was a public
7 employee working for the commonwealth in the course of the
8 employment, the court may extend the notice period by six
9 months.
