AN ACT RELATIVE TO MUNICIPAL EMPLOYEES.

1 *Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to
2 defeat its purpose, which is to immediately allow municipal
3 employees to participate in certain particular matters, therefore it
4 is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the
5 immediate preservation of the public convenience.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Paragraph (a) of section 19 of chapter 268A of
2 the General Laws, as appearing in the 1992 Official Edition, is
3 hereby amended in line 2 by inserting after the word “partici-
4 pates” the following: — as a selectman or a councillor pursuant to
5 section twenty or.

1 SECTION 2. Paragraph (b) of said section 19 of said chapter
2 268A is hereby amended in line 23 by striking the word “municipi-
3 pality.” and by inserting in place thereof the following: — municipi-
4 pality, or (4) if the particular matter involves any matter
5 concerning the employment of a town manager, town adminis-
6 trator, or city manager; provided, that the town manager, town
7 administrator, or city manager is not an immediate family member
8 of the selectman, town councillor, or city councillor.
