AN ACT RELATIVE TO ANOTHER COLUMN ON NOMINATION PAPERS AND INITIATIVE PETITIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 53 section 7 of the Massachusetts
2 General Laws, as appearing in the 1992 Official Edition, is hereby
3 amended by inserting after the word “registered”, in line 3, the
4 words:— and shall insert his or her printed name in the specified
5 column,.

1 SECTION 2. Chapter 53 section 17 of the Massachusetts
2 General Laws, as appearing in the 1992 Official Edition, is hereby
3 amended by inserting after the word “offices”, in line 2, the
4 words:— said forms shall include a column entitled “Printed
5 Name”.

1 SECTION 3. Chapter 53 section 22A of the Massachusetts
2 General Laws, as appearing in the 1992 Official Edition, is hereby
3 amended by inserting after the word “prepared”, in line 15, the
4 words:— Said forms shall include a column entitled “Printed
5 Name”.
