AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING MOTOR VEHICLE INSURANCE RATES FOR CERTAIN DISABLED PERSONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 113B of chapter 175 of the General Laws
2 is hereby amended by inserting after the fourth paragraph, as
3 appearing in the 1988 Official Edition, the following paragraph:—

4 In fixing and establishing classifications of risks, the commis-
5 sioner shall establish rates for insureds who are physically dis-
6 abled and require extensive equipment to drive, which shall be
7 twenty-five percent less than the applicable rate for such classifi-
8 cation.

1 SECTION 2. Clause (d) of section 4 of chapter 175E of the
2 General Laws, as so appearing, is hereby amended by adding the
3 following paragraph:—

4 For motor vehicle insurance rates for an insured who is physi-
5 cally disabled and requires extensive adaptive equipment to drive,
6 shall be twenty-five percent less than the applicable rate for such
7 classification.
