AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE INSTALLATION OF WATER-SAVING DEVICES IN ALL BUILDINGS OWNED BY THE COMMONWEALTH.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 43F of chapter 7 of the General Laws, as  
2 appearing in the 1992 Official Edition, is hereby amended by  
3 adding at the end of the second paragraph the following sen-  
4 tence:— Notwithstanding the provisions of any other section of  
5 this chapter the director shall install or cause to be installed water-  
6 saving devices in all new state buildings, including all state uni-  
7 versities, colleges, prisons, hospitals, court houses and state  
8 offices.

1 SECTION 2. Section 39E of chapter 40 of the General Laws,  
2 as appearing in the 1992 Official Edition, is hereby amended by  
3 adding at the end thereof the following: —

4 Such a board or department may offer rebates to encourage the  
5 installation and usage of water-saving devices in dwellings and  
6 commercial establishments and the commonwealth shall provide  
7 incentives to such cities and towns that embark upon water-saving  
8 techniques and devices.
