RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO THE FEASIBILITY OF USING SURPLUS FEDERAL PROPERTY AS JAILS AND CORRECTIONAL INSTITUTIONS.

1     *Resolved*, That a special commission, to consist of three mem-  
2     bers of the senate, five members of the house of representatives, the  
3     commissioner of the department of correction or his designee and  
4     three persons to be appointed by the governor, is hereby established  
5     for the purpose of making an investigation and study relative to the  
6     feasibility of using surplus federal property in the commonwealth as  
7     jails and correctional institution.
