AN ACT ESTABLISHING A FIVE HUNDRED DOLLAR YEARLY REAL ESTATE TAX ABATEMENT FOR PERSONS SEVENTY YEARS OF AGE AND OVER.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 59, as appearing in the 1986 Official Edition, is  
2 hereby amended by inserting after section 60 the following new  
3 section: —

4 Section 60A. Any city or town which accepts the provisions of  
5 this section shall provide any person seventy years of age and  
6 over and a resident of the commonwealth for the preceding ten  
7 years with an abatement of five hundred dollars on their yearly  
8 real estate tax on their domicile.
