AN ACT PROVIDING FOR AN ADVISORY BOARD ON ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT FOR EACH COUNTY ACCEPTING THIS SECTION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 34 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting
2 after section 14B, inserted by Chapter 197 of the Acts
3 of 1987, the following section: —
4 Section 14C. In any county which accepts this section by vote
5 of the county commissioners, the chairman of the county commis-
6 sioners shall appoint five members to an advisory board on eco-
7 nomic development. Each member to be appointed to three year
8 term. The first appointment to have staggered terms of one year,
9 two years, and three years. The purpose of this advisory board in
10 economic development to advise their county how cooperation
11 between the county and cities and towns may be accomplished.
