AN ACT PROHIBITING THE POSSESSION OF ARMOR PIERCING AMMUNITION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 10 of chapter 269 of the General Laws, as appearing in
2 the 1992 Official Edition is hereby amended by inserting in
3 line 87 after the word: "ends" the following: — any ammunition,
4 as defined in section one hundred and twenty-one of chapter one
5 hundred and forty, which is capable of piercing or penetrating
6 armor or bullet proof vests.
