The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ninety-Five.

AN ACT CONCERNING THE TRANSCRIPT OF STUDENT RECORDS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 General Laws Chapter 71, Section 34A is hereby stricken, and
- 2 the following new Section 34A is inserted:
- 3 Any person operating or maintaining an educational institution
- 4 within the Commonwealth of Massachusetts shall, upon request of
- 5 any student or former student thereof, furnish to his/her a written
- 6 transcript of his/her record as a student providing all tuition and
- 7 charges pursuant to such student have been paid. There shall be no
- 8 charge for any transcript originally furnished by any such person
- 9 hereunder, but for any duplicate of transcript hereunder, a charge
- 10 not exceeding one dollar for each page but not exceeding five
- 11 dollars for any transcript, may be made by such person.
