AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE REGISTRY OF MOTOR VEHICLES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 90, Section 22F of the General Laws, as appearing in
2 the 1990 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding at the end
3 thereof the following new paragraph:—

4 Notwithstanding any provisions of this section to the contrary,
5 the registrar, in his discretion and pursuant to written standards he
6 shall promulgate, is hereby authorized to issue a hardship or pro-
7 bationary license or right to operate in lieu of the mandatory revo-
8 cation required under this section whenever the convictions used
9 to determine habitual traffic offender status are exclusively civil
10 motor vehicle infractions.
