AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE DISPOSITION AND ACQUISITION OF CONSERVATION LAND.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 16 of Chapter 30B of the General Laws, as appearing in
2 the 1990 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding the
3 following paragraph: —

4 (i) this section shall not apply to the rental of conservation land
5 for agricultural purposes which has been deemed as surplus to
6 state needs pursuant to section 40F½ of chapter 7 of the General
7 Laws, nor to other land use for agricultural purposes, nor to the
8 purchase of conservation land by conservation commissions pro-
9 vided, further, that leases for the rental of conservation land for
10 agricultural purposes may be extended, subject to the approval of
11 the city council or board of selectmen, for a period not to exceed
12 ten years if the lessor demonstrates to the satisfaction of the
13 council or board of selectmen that a significant capital investment
14 has been made by the lessor for the purposes of increasing the
15 productivity and value of said land.
