By Mr. Sullivan of Abington, petition of Michael J. Sullivan relative to coastal access for mobile sport fishing. Natural Resources and Agriculture.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ninety-Five.

AN ACT TO PROVIDE REASONABLE COASTAL ACCESS FOR MOBILE SPORT FISHING.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any other provision to the con-
2 trary, the following section is added to M.G.L. Chapter 131:—

3 Whatever method is deemed safe and acceptable for monitor/
4 patrol/official vehicle access through coastal areas subject to pro-
5 visions of M.G.L. Chapter 131 or 131A, the same method shall
6 also be acceptable for mobile sport fishing access.

1 SECTION 2. This provision shall only apply to those beaches
2 allowing recreational Off Road Vehicle use.

1 SECTION 3. No incidental taking of wildlife protected under
2 M.G.L. Chapter 131 or 131A or any regulation pursuant thereto,
3 shall be deemed a criminal or civil offense or violation of law
4 except upon willful, and knowledgeable criminal intent or willful,
5 wanton, and reckless negligence.
