AN ACT RELATIVE TO RETIREMENT FOR MEMBERS OF GROUP 4.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Any member of Group 4 shall be eligible to retire for superan-
2 nuation after twenty years of service at fifty percent of his total
3 annual salary or the highest three years, whichever is greater,
4 regardless of age.

5 Any member of Group 4 shall be eligible to retire for superan-
6 nuation after twenty-five years of service at seventy-five percent
7 of his total salary or the highest three years, whichever is greater,
8 regardless of age.

9 Any member of Group 4 shall be eligible to retire for superan-
10 nuation after thirty years of service at eighty percent of total
11 annual salary, or the highest three years, whichever is greater,
12 regardless of age.
