AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE OFFICE OF MUNICIPAL BUILDING OFFICIALS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 143 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 1988
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after section 3Y
3 the following new section: —

4 Section 3Y½. Any inspector of buildings, building commis-
5 sioner or local inspector so employed pursuant to section three
6 shall not be removed from office nor denied reappointment to
7 such office except after a public hearing has been held by and
8 before the appointing authority. The public hearing may be
9 waived by said employee.
