AN ACT RELATIVE TO LOCAL AID.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the
2 contrary, the Massachusetts Lottery Commission is hereby
3 directed to establish a scratch ticket game to be known as "Red
4 and Blue." Said game shall be established in the same manner as
5 other \$1.00 instant games.

1 SECTION 2. Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 10, Sec-
2 tion 25, as appearing in the 1992 Official Edition, is hereby
3 amended in line 13 following the word "thirty-five" by adding the
4 following:— , with the exception of revenue generated from the
5 instant game to be known as "Red and Blue". All revenues from
6 this game shall be distributed to communities based on the
7 Commonwealth's local aid formula, and shall be used exclusively
8 for municipal police and fire departments.
