AN ACT RELATIVE TO REPORTING ON THE USE OF FUNDS IN THE SPECIAL LAW ENFORCEMENT TRUST FUND.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The third paragraph of subsection (d) of sec-  
2 tion 47 of chapter 94C of General Laws, as appearing in the  
3 1990 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out the  
4 last sentence and inserting in place thereof the following two  
5 sentences: — Within ninety days of the close of the fiscal year,  
6 each district attorney and the attorney general shall file an annual  
7 report with the house and senate committees on ways and means  
8 and with the house and senate committees on the Judiciary on the  
9 use of the monies in the trust fund. Such report shall contain the  
10 total amount of monies and proceeds received in the fiscal year  
11 and the amounts expended in protracted investigations, additional  
12 technical equipment or expertise, matching funds to obtain federal  
13 grants, such other law enforcement purposes deemed appropriate,  
14 drug rehabilitation, drug education and other anti-drug or neigh-  
15 borhood crime watch programs.

1 SECTION 2. The fourth paragraph of subsection (d) of sec-  
2 tion 47 of chapter 94C of the General Laws, as appearing in the  
3 1990 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding at the end  
4 thereof the following sentence: — Within ninety days of the close  
5 of the fiscal year, each chief of police of such city or town shall  
6 file an annual report with the house and senate committees on  
7 ways and means on the use of the monies in the special law  
8 enforcement trust fund.
