

By Mr. DiMasi of Boston, petition of Salvatore F. DiMasi for legislation to authorize purchasers of used motor vehicles the right to waive warranty rights. Commerce and Labor.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ninety-Five.

AN ACT GRANTING THE PURCHASER OF A USED MOTOR VEHICLE THE RIGHT TO WAIVE THEIR WARRANTY RIGHTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any general law, special law, rule, regulation,
2 ordinance or by-law to the contrary, the purchaser of a used motor
3 vehicle shall have the right to waive, in whole or in part, all used
4 motor vehicle warranties and the seller of a used motor vehicle
5 shall have the right to accept said purchaser's waiver of war-
6 ranties, offer to sell and sell used motor vehicle without any war-
7 ranties; provided, however, the seller of used motor vehicle at
8 retail shall provide the purchaser with a federal trade commis-
9 sion's used motor vehicle trade regulation rule "buyers guide" dis-
10 closure form contained in 16 code of federal regulations 455.
