AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE RETIREMENT RIGHTS OF FOREST AND PARK SUPERVISORS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 3(g) of Chapter 32 of the Massachusetts General Laws
- 2 is hereby amended to include the two Forest and Park Supervisors
- 3 in the Department of Environmental Management who supervise
- 4 and instruct inmate crews of the M.C.I. Forestry Camp of Myles
- 5 Standish State Park in Group 4 of the Retirement system.
