## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ninety-Five.

### AN ACT REGARDING THE MASSACHUSETTS STATE POLICE FLEET FUNDING FEE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 33 of Chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in  
2 the 1992 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding the  
3 following paragraph: —

4 For every motor vehicle and trailer registration, effective  
5 July 1, 1994 and running through June 30, 1998, a two dollar law  
6 enforcement fee will be charged which will be forwarded to the  
7 department of state police fleet fund for the specific purposes of  
8 replacing patrol vehicles that have reached approximately 75,000  
9 miles. On July 1, 1998 this fee shall be reduced to one dollar  
10 annually. No fee shall be charged to vehicles exempted from a  
11 registration fee.
