AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE MASSACHUSETTS WATER RESOURCES AUTHORITY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 10 of chapter 372 of the Acts of 1984 is hereby
- 2 amended by adding the following subsection:—
- 3 (c) Notwithstanding any of the foregoing provisions to the con-
- 4 trary, on or before July first, nineteen hundred and ninety-five,
- 5 the authority shall cause all non-residential in the sewer district to
- 6 be equipped with meters to measure sewerage outflow.
- 7 Said authority shall cause the amount of sewage outflow from
- 8 non-residential users to be determined and shall semi-annually
- 9 forward the amount of outflow for each user to the appropriate
- 10 board of assessors who shall base their charges upon such outflow
- 11 determination.
