AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE REGISTRATION OF CERTAIN MOTOR VEHICLES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The registrar of motor vehicles is hereby authorized and
- 2 directed to establish a procedure for the issuance of registration
- 3 plates to be attached to vehicles which are owned for collection
- 4 purposes and are not to be operated on a public way. Said plates
- 5 shall indicate that such vehicle is registered but is uninsured for
- 6 the purpose of liability.
