AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE RECYCLING OF FLUORESCENT LAMPS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the
- 2 Superintendent of State Buildings and the Commissioner of the
- 3 Division of Capital Planning and Operations shall be directed to
- 4 comply with the Environmental Protective Agency's "Green Light
- 5 Program", and in so doing be required to properly dispose of mer-
- 6 cury containing lamps. Recycling shall be used, whenever pos-
- 7 sible, as the preferred method of disposal.
