In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ninety-Five.

AN ACT REGULATING THE SALE OF AUTOMOTIVE PAINT PRODUCTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 94 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting
2 after section 290 the following section: —
3 Section 290A. Except as otherwise provided by the department
4 of environmental protection, no automotive paint product may be
5 sold at retail in the commonwealth to any person not licensed
6 under chapter one hundred A. Said department shall promulgate
7 rules and regulations for the implementation and enforcement of
8 this section, including but not limited to, a determination of which
9 products shall be restricted hereunder and of the proper use of
10 such products.
