AN ACT REQUIRING FACILITIES OF THE COMMONWEALTH WHICH CONSUME NATURAL GAS TO PROCURE SUCH FUEL THROUGH A COMPETITIVE BIDDING PROCESS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 22 of Chapter 7 of the General Laws is hereby amended
2 by inserting the following new section: —
3 “This section shall apply to the purchase of natural gas and
4 associated services, including, but not limited to: commodity
5 acquisition, transportation (both firm and/or interruptible),
6 storage, and delivery. The commodity and associated services may
7 be purchased independently or jointly either directly or through
8 third parties.”
