AN ACT TO SUPPORT PUBLIC EDUCATION.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 59 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 1992  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out from subsec-  
3 tion (f) of section 21C lines 58-60, inclusive, and inserting in  
4 place thereof the following: — exceed an amount equal to one  
5 hundred and two and one half percent of the maximum levy limit  
6 for the preceding fiscal year as determined by the commissioner  
7 of revenue; plus an amount equal to the percent increase in stu-  
8 dent enrollment of the municipality's public school system for the  
9 preceding year, multiplied by the quotient of the amount of the  
10 school department budget plus the amount of the annual debt  
11 service attributable to school buildings and grounds, divided by  
12 the amount of the entire municipal budget;

CHAPTER 27 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF THE STATE OF TEXAS provides that the Legislature shall have the honor of presenting to the Governor a bill for the appropriation of money for the support of the executive branch of the government. The bill shall be accompanied by a report of the committee on the budget, which shall contain a statement of the estimated needs of the executive branch for the fiscal year, and a statement of the estimated resources available for the support of the executive branch. The committee on the budget shall also submit to the Governor a bill for the appropriation of money for the support of the executive branch, which shall be based on the estimated needs and resources of the executive branch for the fiscal year.
