AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE AN APPROPRIATION FROM THE GENERAL FUND FOR THE PURPOSE OF REIMBURSING CERTAIN CITIES AND TOWNS FOR COSTS INCURRED IN COMPLYING WITH CERTAIN REQUIREMENTS OF THE BOARD OF FIRE PREVENTION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 To provide for the costs to the following cities and towns the
 2 sums set forth below are hereby appropriated from the General
 3 Fund for the purpose of reimbursing said cities and towns for
 4 their costs in complying with the regulations of the board of fire
 5 prevention regarding the testing and removal of certain under-
 6 ground storage tanks.
