In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ninety-Five.

RESOLVE IN FAVOR OF JOHN C. BLASI.

1     *Resolved*, That, for the purposes of discharging a moral obliga-  
2     tion of the commonwealth, there shall be allowed and paid out of the  
3     state treasury, subject to appropriation, to John C. Blasi of North  
4     Adams, the sum of nine thousand one hundred dollars which sum  
5     was wrongfully received and kept by the commonwealth due to  
6     erroneous court action by the department of public welfare and the  
7     department of revenue from December eighth, nineteen hundred and  
8     seventy-eight to May eighteenth, nineteen hundred and eighty-eight.

9     No payment shall be made thereunder until there is filed with the  
10    comptroller an agreement signed by said John C. Blasi that the  
11    amount to be paid, if any, for legal services rendered in connection  
12    with the passage of this resolve shall not exceed ten percent of  
13    said sum.
