AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE WORKING HOURS OF CERTAIN PHARMACISTS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 100 of Chapter 149 of the General  
2 Laws, as appearing in the 1988 Official Edition, is hereby  
3 amended by inserting after the first sentence the following sen-  
4 tence: — The provisions of this section shall be applicable to  
5 pharmacists employed by chain-operated pharmacies as defined  
6 by the National Association of Chain Drug Stores.

1 SECTION 2. A copy of section 100 of Chapter 149 of the  
2 General Laws shall be distributed annually to all chain-operated  
3 pharmacies to be posted by the chain-operated drug stores.
