AN ACT RELATIVE TO ASSAULT AND BATTERY ON HACKNEY CARRIAGE OPERATORS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 265 of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by inserting after section 13I the following section: —

3 Section 13J. Whoever commits an assault or assault and battery
4 upon a licensed hackney carriage operator, while said operator is
5 in performance of his duty, shall be punished by imprisonment in
6 the house of corrections for not less than ninety days nor more
7 than two and one-half years, or by a fine of not less than five hun-
8 dred dollars not more than five thousand dollars, or both.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
