AN ACT TO EXPAND STUDENT REPRESENTATION ON SCHOOL COUNCILS IN  
SECONDARY SCHOOLS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 59C of chapter 71 of the General Laws, as amended by  
2 section 53 of chapter 71 of the acts of 1993, is hereby amended  
3 by striking out the second sentence and inserting in place thereof  
4 the following sentence: —

5 Said parents shall have parity with professional personnel on  
6 the school councils; teachers who shall be selected by the  
7 teachers in such school; other persons, not parents or teachers of  
8 students at the school, drawn from such groups or entities as  
9 municipal government, business and labor organizations, institu-  
10 tions of higher education, human services agencies or other inter-  
11 ested groups; and for schools containing any of the grades nine to  
12 twelve, students members attending said grades who shall be  
13 selected annually; provided, however, that the number of said stu-  
14 dent members shall equal the number of parent seats on the  
15 council; and provided, further, that not more than fifty percent of  
16 the council shall be non-school members.
