### AN ACT RELATIVE TO TRANSPORTATION SERVICES FOR RESIDENTS OF LONG TERM CARE FACILITIES

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Section 4 of Chapter 19A of the General Laws is hereby amended
- 2 by inserting, after paragraph (p), the following:—
- 3 (q) to provide transportation for residents of long term care facili-
- 4 ties licensed pursuant to section seventy-one of chapter one hundred
- 5 and eleven of the General Laws, for the purpose of transporting resi-
- 6 dents to such areas, facilities, and functions as will encourage the
- 7 integration of such residents into the communities in which their
- 8 facilities are located, and provide an opportunity for such residents
- 9 to participate in activities outside the facility in which they reside.
