AN ACT RELATIVE TO CIVIL SERVICE PLACEMENT FOR JOHN M. RIDGE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law or  
2 rule or regulation to the contrary, John M. Ridge, of the city of  
3 Boston, for the purposes of civil service eligibility list for the  
4 position of police officer shall be considered a son of a police  
5 officer as set forth in section twenty-six of chapter thirty-one of  
6 the General Laws provided that he passes the required written and  
7 physical examinations for entrance to police service.
